

ICE DRIVING IN THE SWEDISH LAPLANDS

Saturday 17 - Thursday 22 February*



rrive into Stockholm to convene for A mid-morning flight to Arjeplog. Here in the pristine Swedish Laplands you begin your ice driving experience. Each winter, Arjeplog's Lake Udjaur is transformed into a 1,250-acre driving area. Featuring 13 exceptional tracks totaling nearly 50 kilometres, you will test your limits on exclusive, fullscale replicas of legendary F1 tracks such as Paul Ricard, Nürburgring, and Silverstone, as well as smaller yet challenging training circuits.

Over the course of two days and around 200 kilometres, you will put yourself in the shoes of some of motorsport's greatest racers. The tour includes training to develop your ice driving skills and test your endurance

as you take on a range of technical tracks in specially-prepared vehicles. Qualified instructors are on hand to give you personalised coaching and help you build the confidence, control, and performance required to master these tracks. You will also gain skills specific to ice driving, including drifting at high speed - up to 200km/h.

Keep your eyes peeled for supercar prototypes. Many high-performance supercar marques use Arjeplog as a cold-weather testing facility for new models, meaning you stand a good chance of spotting next year's Mercedes or Ferrari sliding across the ice. Look for a distinctive camouflage wrap on the vehicle's bodywork to spot them. Non-driving partners will find plenty

to enjoy during their time in Lapland. Mornings can be spent either relaxing at the hotel, or taking in some of the ice driving - the choice is yours. Should you be inspired by the action on track, you can also opt to get behind the wheel for a couple of laps yourself. In the afternoons, an exciting variety of options await, including a road trip up into the Arctic Circle, dog sledding, and a laidback afternoon at the spa.

The adrenaline rush continues with a snowmobile expedition to explore the wild beauty of the region's most secluded areas. Later that day, the group will return to Stockholm on the afternoon flight before spending an evening in the city to relax after a big couple of days. In Stockholm, you will

check into the luxurious Grand Hotel on the waterfront, before enjoying an evening at Mathias Dahlgren's renowned restaurant, Matbaren.

The next morning is yours to relax before onward travel, or transfers to the airport for guests continuing on with the Arctic Trucking experience in Iceland. Often referred to as Venice of the north, Stockholm is a beautiful archipelago featuring 14 islands connected by 57 bridges. We suggest taking a morning stroll through the Old Town's cobblestone streets. Surrounded by medieval buildings, you may feel as though you have stepped back in time.

After settling in, the group will reconvene to spend an afternoon at the Blue Lagoon. The Blue Lagoon Geothermal Spa is a world-renowned natural wonder situated on a peninsula

with a backdrop of stunning Icelandic landscape. Enjoy the spa's extensive wellness facilities, including indoor and outdoor mineral pools of varying heat, saunas, steam rooms, a waterfall, and various relaxation areas. Be sure to visit the swim-up bar and sample one of the refreshing premium cocktails.

In the evening, we will dine at The Retreat's celebrated Lava Restaurant – a foodie destination showcasing Iceland's unique culinary heritage. Afterwards, you can retire for the evening, or stay up for your first chance to get a glimpse of the natural spectacle of the Aurora Borealis (Northern Lights). Caused as a result of proximity to the magnetic North Pole, on a clear night above Reykjavik, the sky is often lit

ablaze by pulsating light forms, usually of a stunning green or purple hue. There are few better places on Earth to experience this phenomenon than in the heart of the Arctic Circle.

Your Arctic Trucking experience will begin the following morning. As part of the experience, the group will venture into the Icelandic Highlands to test the prowess of custom-built 4WD vehicles in some of the harshest conditions imaginable. A rugged landscape of uninhabitable volcanic desert, the Highlands are desolate yet hauntingly beautiful – cameras are essential to capture the otherworldly landscapes. In the evening, you will have another opportunity to see the incredible Aurora Borealis.

The Arctic Trucking adventure continues the following morning with a journey south-east to the Valley of Thor. This stunning valley is backdropped by an epic landscape of mountain ridges, rivers and volcanic glaciers. As we explore the valley, you will be able to take photos of some of the most picturesque natural features, including Seljalandsfoss Waterfall – one of the country's most spectacular water features – as well as Stakkholtgjá Canyon and Gígjökull Glacier

As day turns into night, we will return to Reykjavik. On the final evening, you will stay in the county's newest five-star hotel offering, The Edition, and enjoy dinner by Iceland's first Michelin-star Chef, Gunnar Karl Gíslason, at Tides.


