

ove Formula 1? Then join us in

Melbourne at our private corporate suite for one of the first Grand Prix weekends of the season.

The Australian Grand Prix is the second oldest surviving motor racing competition held in Australia, as well as one of the few street races in the world. Held in Melbourne since 1996, the 16-turn, 5.3 kilometre circuit is built utilising a combination of public roads and a car park within Albert Park.

Those opting to kick off the trip with this experience can choose to join us for the F1 Practice Sessions on Friday. Alternatively, you can enjoy a relaxing day off, or get out and make the most of the cosmopolitan city of Melbourne, which comes alive during GP weekend. Saturday is Qualifying, and one of our favourite days to spend exploring the circuit and grounds, meeting up with friends old and new, and making the most of the hospitality on offer.

Of course, Sunday is race day, where you can join us in the suite to cheer on your favourite driver and team. Call us biased, but we are always excited to see how Australian F1 Driver Daniel Ricciardo performs in his orange livery as part of team McLaren.

EXPLORE TASMANIA'S BEST DRIVING ROADS

Monday 11 - Saturday 16 March*



Your Tasmanian odyssey begins in Melbourne, where the group will meet at a central starting point, before convoying together to Geelong to take the overnight ferry to Tasmania.

The first drive day is the perfect warm up to the week. After disembarking from the ferry, we will stop for a light breakfast. From here, your day cuts east across one of Australia's most dramatic and beautiful forest-to-coast drives, which also includes a number of famed Targa Tasmania stages.

Before lunch, you will travel a series of incredible twisty roads bordered by lush nature reserves. This scenery gives way to the golden sands and turquoise waters of the Tasman Sea. Along the

route, the convoy will stop for a fresh seafood lunch in St Helens, then continue onto the incredibly scenic Coles Bay. Tonight you will stay at the picturesque Freycinet Lodge within the Freycinet National Park.

Day two of the drive will see the convoy cross back west across a series of forest reserves and up into the Great Lakes Conservation Area. In the afternoon, you will again enjoy a series of renowned roads that feature on the Targa rally, before stopping by a truffle hunting farm. That evening, the drive will conclude at Peppers Cradle Mountain, which offers rustic cabins and incomparable views of the gorgeous lake and mountains of this UNESCO Heritage Area.

The following morning, the group will take in the remote yet stunning West Coast of Tasmania, experiencing the infamous '99 bends', a section of curvaceous, silky-smooth tarmac that traverses a mountain range between the mining town of Queenstown and Derwent. This is a great section of road for drivers looking to put their car through its paces. After lunch in a charming historic hydroelectric village, we'll continue onto Hobart.

Once the convoy arrives into Hobart, you can trade car keys for Champagne and spend the afternoon relaxing at the hotel. From here, you will enjoy a private cruise down the Derwent River before an evening at the picturesque Peppermint Bay Restaurant.

Your final day of the drive will see the group enjoy a deserved sleep in, followed by lunch at the award-winning Frogmore Creek. From Hobart we will head up the centre of this beautiful island via the rugged Great Western Tiers, Central Plateau, and Great Lake Conservation Areas, offering a stunning backdrop of craggy ridges, wetlands and historic homesteads. In the late evening, the convoy will arrive at the scenic Ghost Rock winery for a final supper before boarding the Spirit of Tasmania for the return leg home.

On Saturday morning we will disembark early. Guests who have time can enjoy a relaxed final breakfast together before departing for onward travel plans.

DAY 1: MONDAY 11 MARCH ARRIVAL + WELCOME

For interstate guests, arrive in Melbourne by mid-afternoon. Your car, having been transported from your home, will be securely stored and waiting for your arrival.

All guests will then meet at Lorbek Luxury Cars in the early afternoon for an official welcome before making the drive to Geelong to board the Spirit of Tasmania.

DAY 2: TUESDAY 12 MARCH **DRIVE DAY ONE**

The Spirit of Tasmania docks early. After disembarking at Devonport, the group will drive directly to the Tasmanian Food and Wine Conservatory for breakfast. From here you will cover the renowned roads out to and along the East Coast, one of Australia's most dramatic forest-to-coast drives. Your drive includes renowned Targa stages, such as Sideling, Moorina and Pyengana.

In the afternoon, you will enjoy lunch on the coast followed by an evening at Freycinet Lodge with dinner at The Bay Restaurant.

In the early evening we will arrive into your next hotel for the evening, a charming chalet style property complete with high ceilings, dark oak wood and fireplaces that are best enjoyed with a large glass of red.

Famous roads along the way include the epic '99 bends' stretch from Queenstown to the Derwent Bridge. Along the way you will stop for lunch at the charming Tarraleah Estate, before continuing on to Hobart.

In the evening you will have some downtime to enjoy the hotel before we depart via

catamaran for an evening cruise down the Derwent River to the picturesque Peppermint Bay restaurant.

How does the driving work?

The drive operates in a loose convoy, with a lead and sweep car (driven by professional drivers), and two-way radio contact between all vehicles. The lead car navigates for the convoy and provides updates on conditions, so drivers can focus on enjoying the cars and drive. The sweep car ensures that no one becomes lost or separated from the group.

The drive per day is around 250km/155mi over 6-8 hours including regular stops for morning/afternoon tea, lunch, and driver/ car changes.

What type of roads do we drive?

Our team has spent over a decade researching and testing the best roads in the world. All tours are planned so as to avoid heavily trafficked cities and seek out the freedom of the open road. The routes chosen for our tours cover a variety of road types that accentuate both the location and the tour type. You can expect to navigate tight switchbacks and hairpins on alpine passes, and then enjoy loose,

flowing country backroads, and fast-paced autostradas. We always choose roads that are incredibly scenic, so whether you are behind the wheel or in the passenger seat for a section, you will find plenty to enjoy.

What type of guests join your tours?

Guests from around the world attend our tours. We typically host a mixture of groups of friends, families, business associates, and plenty of couples. While we do recommend sharing the experience with someone you know or as a group, we also cater for guests coming on their own. In this case, you will be partnered with another solo driver.

Ultimately, our tour groups are made up of like-minded people who share a passion for motoring, and enjoying the finer things in life. Many go on to keep in contact after the tour and often become life-long friends.

How does pricing work?

Your tour package is priced per person and is based on two people per vehicle. Typically the driving is shared between occupants, who alternate between being behind the wheel and being a passenger. In the case that one participant prefers not to drive, the other will be able to enjoy double the time behind the wheel, while the passenger can soak up the stunning scenery and excitement of riding along. As outlined on page 12–14, your Tour Investment consists of your Tour Package and any Optional Add-Ons.

Where do guests stay and dine?

Accommodation and dining are designed to complement your overall experience. Our team seeks out the most luxurious and unique hotels in the regions we visit, which can include ornate castles, private villas, boutique resorts, and more. Dining is always a social affair, pairing gourmet cuisine with fine wine, over which the group can share stories and experiences.

Depending on the size of the group, guests may stay as a collective, or diverge into smaller groups at nearby luxury hotels, commensurate with your selected package. Accommodation packages and upgrades dictate the hotel and room category.
